This project upholds the Chamber's mission to help our communities on the South Coast thrive by advocating for responsible policy, supporting visitor services, and developing community-building opportunities.

The project will bring better biking and walking to our Westside and Lower West community members. In addition to four area schools, the project area is home to parks, a retail center, and several community centers.
