# California 2022 Ballot Propositions

Vote recommendations by the *Tri-County Chamber Alliance*

NP*	Prop 1	Constitutional amendment that bars the state from denying or interfering with a person's access to abortion or contraceptives.
NP*	Prop 26	Legalizes in-person sports betting at tribal casinos and designated horse tracks for persons 21 years or older.
NO	Prop 27	Legalizes online and mobile sports betting for persons 21 years and older in California.
NP*	Prop 28	Requires state to set aside General Fund revenue for art and music classes in all public K-12 public schools (including charter schools).
NO	Prop 29	Places numerous new restrictions on dialysis clinics, including a requirement that a doctor, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant be on site during all treatment hours.
NO	Prop 30	Would impose a new 1.75% tax increase on personal income over \$2 million per year for individuals and couples.
NP*	Prop 31	Overturns SB 793, which banning the sale of all flavored tobacco products in California. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A YES vote <u>upholds</u> SB 793, banning the sale of flavored tobacco products</li><li>• A NO vote <u>repeals</u> SB 793, keeping the sale of flavored tobacco legal</li></ul>

\*NP recommendation means the initiative does not fall within the strategic initiatives of the Tri-County Chamber Alliance.
