Chair Parke and Planning Commissioners:

The Santa Barbara South Coast Chamber of Commerce, representing businesses from Goleta to Carpinteria and 75,000 jobs in the region, would like to express our support for the Bailard Workforce and Affordable Housing Project.

The need for more housing in southern Santa Barbara County is not a new issue, regardless of State mandates. Housing has always been a challenge for local employers and their employees. In fact, struggling to attract and retain employees due of the high cost and lack of housing stock is the number one issue we hear from local businesses. This pre-established need for increased housing supply in our region, in addition to State mandates, require the County to identify the housing projects that make sense for our communities and work to see them completed. We believe that the Bailard Housing Project is one of those projects.
