The Santa Barbara South Coast Chamber of Commerce, representing businesses across Goleta, Santa Barbara, and Carpinteria, would like to express our support for fiscal year 2024 Congressionally Directed Spending for the Santa Barbara County Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure Installation Project.

This project request by the County of Santa Barbara would install 150 to 175 Level-2 and DC Fast Charging Stations countywide. Many of these electric vehicle chargers will be shared by County fleet vehicles and the public. This project will not only help electrify the County fleet, but it will also encourage further adoption of electric vehicles throughout the region. This electric vehicle charging infrastructure project will be a big step forward in supporting the transition to zero-emission vehicles throughout our County.
